ABOUT THE WORLD AROUND

The World Around is a global non-profit platform with a clear and ambitious mission: to make the best new ideas in architecture accessible to all.

Founded in New York in 2020, the organization seeks to connect and create a diverse and global network of the most innovative makers and thinkers today through international public programs, exhibitions and educational initiatives. All talks, conversations and discussions are livestreamed and archived on The World Around website and YouTube channel.

Collaborative in essence and global in scope, The World Around has four pillars: an Annual Summit in New York City, created to convene and champion the now, near, and next of architecture; In Focus programs, which meet the moment in world cities with thematic curation; an online channel of live broadcasts, interviews and talks; and its inspiring Young Climate Prize award and mentorship program.

Over the past five years, The World Around has covered the work of designers from over 150 global locations, each who have shared visionary work on topics that range from ecological destruction to social and racial justice; food scarcity to homelessness; video game design and artificial intelligence to spoken word and literature.

The World Around works closely with a growing network of international curatorial and institutional partners that includes Museum of Modern Art, NY, Nieuwe Instituut, Rotterdam; Design Museum, London, Power Station of Art, Shanghai and its Global Cultural Partner, Fondation Cartier pour l'art contemporain, Paris.

LIFE ON EARTH


Life On Earth explores the evolving relationship between design and our planet through on-the-ground interviews and videos documenting the work and ideas of exceptional contemporary architects commissioned and produced by The World Around, alongside stories of intergenerational learning and collaboration from participants in The World Around Young Climate Prize. While zooming in on issues from resource depletion to habitat destruction; natural disasters to the enduring legacies of colonialism, the exhibition highlights the practitioners who are repositioning architecture as a medium for worldbuilding, imagining new forms of life for a planet under threat.

On the first screen, *Designing the Planet*, the videos travel from the salt flats of Argentina to the caves of Kenya's Great Rift Valley, examining the human systems that have reshaped our planet. On screen two, *Imagining Alternatives*, the videos follow visionary leaders in search of new, less harmful ways to inhabit the Earth. The final screen presents *Sustaining the Future*, a series of international dispatches from the individuals and communities who are building real change.

The multidisciplinary array of speakers features: Alice Rawsthorn (UK), Cave_Bureau (Kenya), Comunal (Mexico), David Chipperfield (UK), Deanna Van Buren (USA), Ecocitex (Chile), El Futuro Imposible (Argentina), Ensamble Studio (Spain), Ernesto Picco (Argentina), Etta Madete Mukuba (Kenya), Feral Atlas (USA, China), Formafantasma (Italy), Francis Kéré (Burkina Faso/Germany), Holly Jean Buck (USA), Hsieh Ying-Chun (Taiwan), Liam Young (Australia), Top Manta (Senegal and Spain), and waiwai (UAE).

Through revealing the interconnected nature of life on our planet, *Life On Earth* aims to emphasize the necessity—and urgency—of collective action in addressing climate breakdown, and to invite a broader discussion on the role of the architect in the Anthropocene.


